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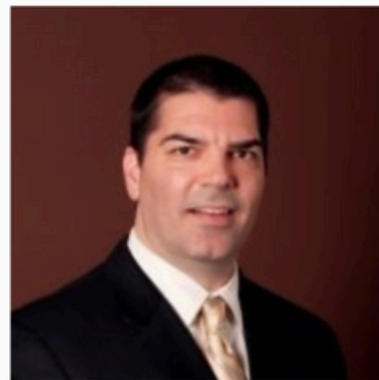
Where to Catch DHIN

Panelists will share strategies for managing payer relationships by using data to enhance decision-making and reimbursement processes. 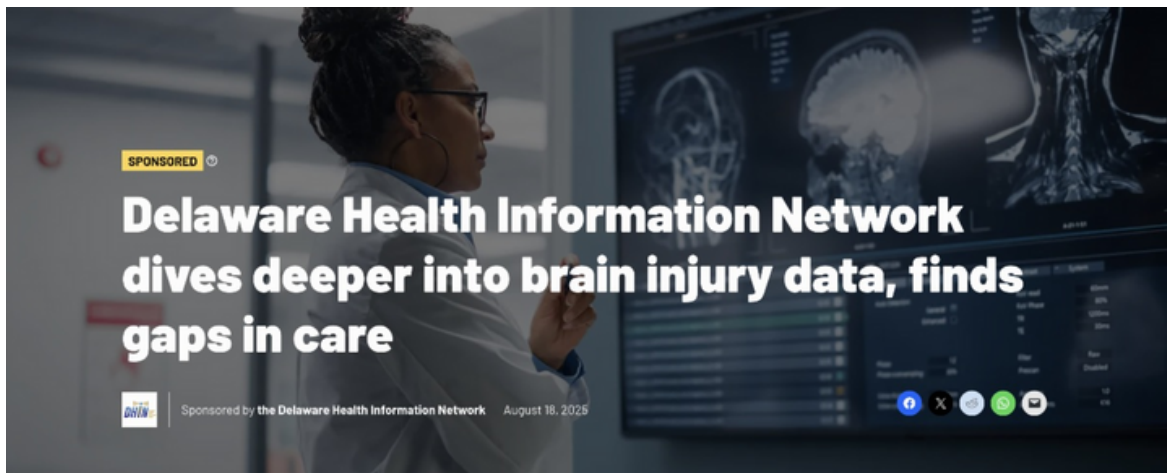

The Delaware State Council for Persons with Disabilities (SCPD) updated the [Traumatic Brain Injury \(TBI\) Fund Assistant Application](#) for individuals with TBIs and their supporters to apply for help and other resources. SCPD updated the application to be in plain language and more user-friendly after hearing from individuals with TBIs and their families, who stated the application was confusing and lengthy.

How to Join TEFCA Through DHIN

As a reminder: your organization can participate in [TEFCA](#) through DHIN! Organizations must be active senders of information, such as Customer Care Summaries (CCDs), with DHIN. Once the organization has established itself as a member of DHIN's network, and testing and approvals have been completed, the organization will be able to access TEFCA's exchange through DHIN.

TEFCA is a nationwide health information exchange made of a network of Qualified Health Information Networks (QHINs) that connect directly with each other to share health records electronically among healthcare providers, patients, public health agencies and payers. Joining TEFCA allows for an organization to be up to date with the national health data exchange standards required by CMS while improving health information gathering and decreasing costs.
