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Community Health Record - Enhancement



The Community Health Record (CHR) was recently upgraded with new enhancements to provide more patient data and to help with reporting issues. A new "Claims" tab was added to the CHR and it provides a summary of available patient pharmacy claims data. More claims data will be coming in the future.

There were also a few features added to help users with issues, including a new "Report an Issue" button added to the Patient Summary section of the CHR. The button allows users to report issues tied to a specific patient chart directly to DHIN's Service Desk. The Service Desk request form has also been updated.

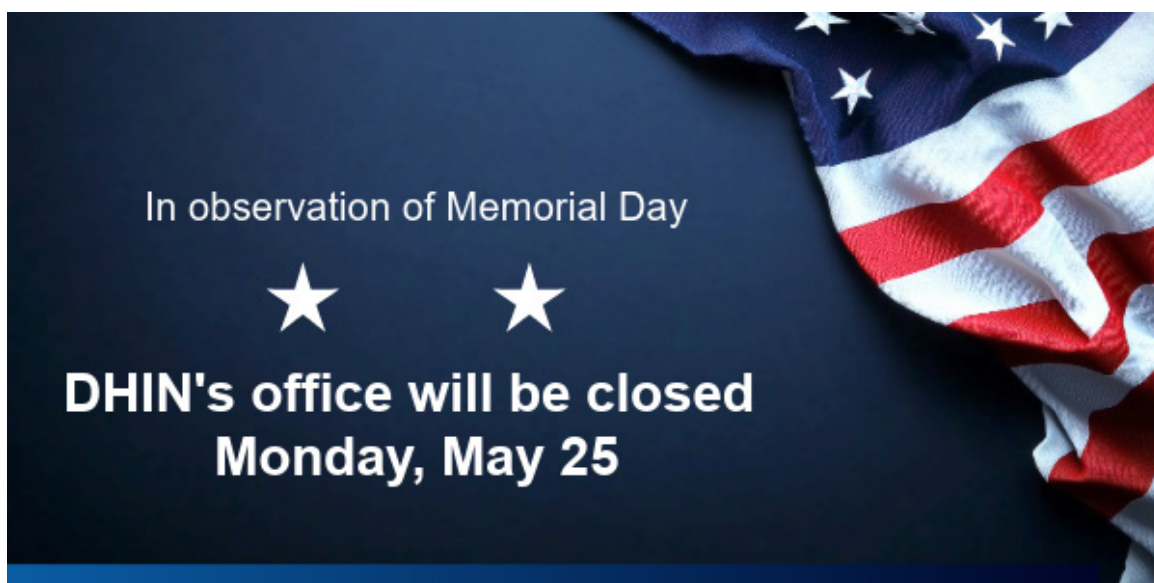
